

 FOR FY 2024's POLICY AND RESEARCH PROGRAM**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 16, s. 2017, "Research Management Guidelines", and in line with RM No. 021, s. 2024, "Research Management Cycle 2024", this Office, through the Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD) in close coordination with the Regional Research Committee (RRC), announces the **Call for Submission of Action Research (AR) Proposals for FY 2024's Policy and Research Program**.

2. Relative to this, the RRC and Schools Division Research Committees (SDRCs) shall conduct the following preliminary activities as anchored on RMG:

Correspondingly, the SDRCs are required to submit four (4) AR proposals: (1) teaching and learning and (1) literacy and numeracy (*classroom-based research*) to be conducted by "teaching personnel" to ensure that learning outcomes are achieved as well as (1) support program (*school-based/ district-based*) and (1) organizational development (*SDO-based/ RO-initiated/ office-based*) AR studies to be conducted by "teaching-related" and "non-teaching personnel" to likewise reinforce the intermediate outcome on enabling mechanisms for the improvement of the Department's internal processes and systems to modernize governance and educational management. Hence, the research ideas outlined in the to-be submitted AR proposals should carry the potential to be translated into outputs, practices, or systems that can create value to the organization and its clientele; and results in workplace improvements through efficiency in operations, increased productions, improved working standards, and/or savings in the government spending.

Furthermore, the AR Proposals should follow the prescribed outline stipulated in the institutional format of DepEd Region VII-Central Visayas known as *Supplemental Writing Resources for Innovative Teaching and Engaging Strategies* (SWRITES): Simplified Research Guide for AR Proposals which is then anchored on DepEd Order No. 16, s.2017, Research Management Guidelines.
6. The recommended AR Proposals for Policy Research Program 2024 must also be duly endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendents (SDS) of the counterpart SDOs or by the Functional Division (FD) Chiefs for those research proponents from the Regional Office.
7. The Schools Division Research Coordinators and/or Senior Education Program Specialists for Planning and Research Unit are requested to upload the softcopies of the SDO-approved AR Proposals and corresponding documentary requirements (MS Word and PDF) affixed with electronic signature, and attached with (i) assessment checklist and (ii) criteria guide or scoring rubric with corresponding remarks through the following link: <https://bit.ly/BERF2024-ARProposals>. The file to be uploaded shall follow this filename format: SDO_Name of Lead Proponent, e.g. (SDO-Dumaguete_She Writes) or PPRD7_She Writes.
8. The BERF 2024 Prospective Grantees are then requested to prepare corresponding powerpoint presentations of their AR Proposals following the prescribed format. The day and time slots for the presenters per SDO shall be announced in subsequent issuances.
9. All expenses incurred relative to the conduct of this research activity shall be charged to Regional/ Division MOOE or Local Funds/ BERF 2024 PRP Funds, subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
10. Lastly, relative to the conduct of the 2024 RM Cycle, Regional or Division Technical Working Group/ Secretariat Members shall be then scheduled to visit the SDOs and/or schools for dissemination initiatives, capacity building activities for proposal writing and funding opportunities, and other related advocacies.
