

SUBJECT : REVIEW AND FORMULATION OF NEW NORMATIVE FUNDING
FORMULA FOR THE SCHOOL MAINTENANCE AND OTHER
OPERATING EXPENSES (SMOOE)

This is in reference to the review and formulation of new normative funding formula for the School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (SMOOE) to determine a more sufficient allocation for each school.

The overall objective of the study is to propose a new normative funding formula for School SMOOE). The formula should cover allocations or school SMOOE for both elementary and secondary education and should take into consideration some of the cost drivers of school SMOOE (number of students, number of teachers, etc.) as well as other relevant factors such as school location.

A survey will be conducted to be able to collect data from a sample of DepEd schools of different curriculum offerings (i.e., K - 6, Grade 7 to Grade 10, SHS, K-10, K - 12, Grade 7 - Grade 12); delivery mode (mono grade vs. multigrade); and, Senior High School track offered on their actual school SMOOE expenditures by major expense item (water, electricity, communication (internet, telephone), supplies and materials, travel expense, training expense, repair and maintenance, job order for security/utility, etc.) regardless of funding source (i.e., GAA, LGU, PTCA contribution, canteen funds, private donations).

Moreover, after consolidating the results of the survey, a focus group discussion among selected schools might be conducted by the Asian Development Asian (ADB) together with the concerned DepEd office in order to gain deeper insights, perspectives, and understanding of the findings.
