Qualifications of Participants:

- Girls** - must be registered Junior, Senior & Cadet Girl Scouts as of June 30, 2024
- must be physically fit and alert as certified by a licensed physician
- must have earned at least one badge under the challenge of Environment, Preparedness, Arts, Heritage & Citizenship
- Adult** - must be registered Troop Leader as of June 30, 2024
- must have undertaken the Outdoor Leadership Course or must be a Campcraft Certificate Holder
- must be physically fit to undergo the rigor of outdoor life
- must know and understand her girls
- must know simple First Aid

A Physical re-check shall be conducted upon arrival in camp. Be sure that the Girls shall be bringing with them their individual Health Form and Parent's Consent Form during the physical re-check.


